Leaders and instructional coaches focus on implementation and support of best blended learning practices, integration of effective technology to achieve student-centered outcomes, and observation and feedback of blended learning classrooms. (20-hour online course)

Two course online series: Designing Project-Based Instruction and Blended Learning (30 hours) and Implementing Project-Based Instruction and Blended Learning (20 hours).



More than 3,200 Texas teachers and administrators from 120 districts have participated in UTeach Blended Learning professional development.




